## Rules and Regulations for 2009 Newton County Little Miss Contest

1. Contestants must be at least 5 years of age by July 1, 2009 and cannot have reached his/her 8<sup>th</sup> birthday by August 31, 2009.
2. All Contestants must be Newton County residents. One of the contestant's parents or legal guardian must also be a Newton County resident and have lived in Newton County for at least 6 months.
3. Any contestant who has performed or competed on the professional level, (for monetary gain) in anything other than amateur contests will be considered ineligible for this contest.
4. For the interview **and** stage portion of the contest, all contestants should wear casual, age appropriate, summer clothes.
5. Any contestant winning the Newton County Little Miss and Mister Contest cannot compete in the contest again.
6. **NO ONE, INCLUDING PARENTS, WILL BE PERMITTED BACKSTAGE DURING JUDGING OR PUBLIC CONTEST** (rehearsal, interview, and public contest) except the appointed committee members.
7. If any of the rules and responsibilities listed on this sheet are not followed by the contestants and their parents, the Newton County Little Miss and Mister Director has the right to disqualify the contestant(s) from competition.
8. While there will not be a talent portion to our program; each child will answer questions on stage during the public contest.
9. While not required, the Little Miss and Mister and runners-up may represent Newton County local parades, and during the 2009 fair.
10. The Newton County Little Miss and Mister Contest director reserves the right to change the foregoing rules and regulations at any time as may be needed.
11. All contestants and their parents must attend a **mandatory meeting** for a Q/A session and stage practice for the children. This meeting will be held **Wednesday, July 8, 2009 at 6:30 p.m.** at the Connell Building in the Newton County Fairgrounds; you will be notified by mail or telephone of any change in this date, time or place.
12. A sponsor fee of \$25.00 must be paid in full at the time of the parent meeting.
13. All registration forms must be received by or turned in at the July 8 mandatory meeting.
